- Establish and maintain appropriate relationships with students, parents, and volunteers according to Trinity Baptist Church policies.

- Recruit, train, and lead adult volunteers to spiritually and intentionally invest in students.
- Connect the students and student ministry to the greater body of believers at Trinity.
- Be actively present in the community and school system.
- Develop relationships and rapport with the greater Trinity Sweetwater Family.
- Function as a member of the Pastoral Team in matters of pastoral care.
- Carry out other assignments determined by the Lead Pastor.
